Overview

This event will be looking at what personalisation means for people with LD from minority communities. We will look at different models, key pieces of policy and hear from service users and from families and personal assistants. By the end of the day, attendees will have a clear idea of the benefits for BME families of personalising services, an understanding of the pitfalls they may face and possible ways to overcome these.

In this one day course we will look at:

- What personalisation means for people from minority communities, different models, direct payments, individual budgets, personal budgets.
- Providing information and advice to people who use services and their families. Helping them understand and utilise the new models.
- Share examples of people who have their own budgets and how this has worked for them.
- What is 'Co-production' - how service users with learning disabilities can influence social care development.
- Look at changes in the social care workforce - Supporting the new types of worker.
- Explore options around how you are supported and the way that you want it to look i.e. brokerage, directly employing people, or going to an agency.
